

AAPFCO Annual Meeting
August 3, 2005
St. Pete Florida

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Garry Wagner with 22 in attendance, 18 AAPFCO and 4 industry.

A report was given on the 2004 Volunteer Inspectors Seminar by Dan Danielson and Brett Groves. Sixty five inspectors attended representing 20 states. Included in the training was a fertilizer plant tour with hands on training at a local co-op. Sixty dollars was turned back to the associations involved in the training.

Kenny Naylor of Oklahoma gave a report on the 2005 Inspector training in Oklahoma City. Brett Groves and Kenny Naylor have developed the Program and have selected the Holiday Inn Airport.

Roger Hostenbach reported on the Oklahoma City Administrator Seminar, the attendance was 26 registrants, the topics discussed were Bulk Compost, BMP's and security in Oklahoma. The media representative from the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture gave a presentation on dealing with the press. The 2005 administrators Seminar will be held November 10-12 at the Benson Hotel in Portland Oregon. The 2006 and 2007 seminars will be in Savanna Georgia and Nashville Tennessee Respectively.

New business was introduced by Brett Groves and concerned changing the format for the inspector training. Brett and Kenny Naylor have worked on adding safety and current issues for AAPFCO and adjusting some of the program.
